**To the Embassy of India in the
Republic of Tajikistan**

Tajik Ministry of Agriculture presents its compliments to the Embassy of India and as per your letter of DUS/204/1/2010-III dated 29 July 2011 has the honour to inform as follows:

According to the Article 10 of Tajik Law "On Quarantine of plants" every subquarantine material, imported in or exported from Tajikistan, is to have a phytosanitary certificate, issued by an authorized government body for quarantine of plants of the country-exporter and quarantine permission for import.

As per the Article 11 of Tajik Law "On quarantine of plants" subquarantine material, imported in Tajikistan, is to be subject to a compulsory state quarantine phytosanitary control and examination. Subquarantine material, imported through check points of Tajik state border to the territory of Tajikistan, is to be subject to a primary state quarantine phytosanitary control and examination and when reaching its destinations it is to be subject to a secondary state quarantine phytosanitary control and examination as well.

The Ministry also brings to your notice that Service of the state inspection for a phytosanitation and quarantine of plants under Tajik Ministry of Agriculture is authorized to carry out the indicated measures.
