2.	Activities	To achieve its objectives, APEDA undertakes various export promotion activities which includes participation in various International trade events by setting up of Indian pavilion (theme pavilion as well as stands for exporters) to display and to facilitate development and promotion of Agricultural and Processed Food Products of various exporters.		
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3.	Scope of Work	With the objective to have uniform design APEDA pavilion in all the above mentioned events, APEDA proposes to invite agencies submit the Design which can be used in all the 4 exhibitions as mentioned above.	
		The scope of work for the above mentioned events shall include the following:	
		Conceptualization of overall theme for Exhibition & Theme Pavilion.	
		2. Designing and Creativeness of APEDA Pavilion including built up stands of the exporters/participants of international quality standard for the above 4 events.	
		3. Creating a suitable Indian brand for the focus products (Indian organic produce and fresh fruits and vegetables) for the events proposed above.	
		4. Preparation of floor plan with optimum utility of space allotted for each fair.	
		5. Preparation of Detailed BOQ (Bill of Quantity) for finalization of Construction /Fabrication Agency.	
		6. The selected vendor whose design is approved will also prepare and develop a Tender Document for Construction/Fabrication with approved designs, layouts etc. for each fair as mentioned in Point No. 2 above.	
4.	Brief Requirements	The proposed APEDA pavilion will be designed in the complete wooden material including the common area, sampling and participant's area. The scope of work for the Event shall include the following:	
		Common area on raised platform (Excluding the exhibitor stalls) in an approx. area of 35-100 Sq. mtr. (varies for each exhibition) with adequate space for wet sampling will include:	
		1. Meeting room with sofa sitting and open sitting with round table and chairs as the case may be.	
		2. Top mounted hanging, wherever permissible.	
		3. Custom built wet sampling area with adequate storage area, display counters, shelves, microwave oven, chiller, freezer etc.	
		4. The overall look of India pavilion should be contemporary and reflect the colour	

		branding has to be done and shall be followed all over with optimal utilization of all dimensions (specifically top section). 5. The space provided to exhibitions will be of 9sqm and its multiples as per the requirement of each exhibition or as per the Guidelines of the Organizers of the each exhibition. 6. The stalls should have the provision of following minimum requirements: a. One lockable counter b. One round table c. Four chairs d. 3 shelves e. 8 spotlights of 100watt each f. 1 store of 1m 8 1m g. Represent a dynamic and vibrant showcase of India; h. Include creative design structures i. Space for projection and product display j. Optimum utilization of space. k. Pavilion shall be well lit and there shall be no dark corners. l. Adequate arrangements for storage should be planned; m. Bulk structures and backlit forms are highly avoidable.
5.	Eligibility Criteria	Agencies having following minimum qualifications are hereby invited to apply for the above mentioned activities: - The Agency should be able to provide a qualified creative team for undertaking the project for APEDA and should demonstrate experience in handling large scale projects at international level of comparable stature. Agencies need to have a strong design and aesthetic sense with comprehensive ability to conceive and execute design ideas. - Must be a registered business entity/service provider. Registration no. of TAN/Direct tax/Income tax/Trade Tax/VAT/GST, etc. as applicable may be quoted in the technical bids format and copy of the certificate/proof must be attached. These documents should be in the name of applicant organization only and not that of group/sister organizations. In other words, name of applicant organization should be same in all the documents submitted.

A minimum of 5 years experience in conceptualizing, designing of pavilions in International events abroad (not less than 200sqm.) each year. Attach supporting documents. A turnover of minimum of Rupees Five Crores only during the preceding financial year, i.e., 2017-18. Attach CA certificate. Attach supporting documents towards Awards received for designing of pavilions international exhibitions abroad. Submission of EMD in the form of DD for the amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) in favour of "APEDA" payable at New Delhi is essential for the bid without which the bid offer will be rejected. A self certified undertaking has to be submitted mentioning that they have never been black listed by any government organization and it so, the same is not applicable as on date. Submission of Design in Pendrive (open file on Autocad format) along with print copy. Application Proforma for submission of Bid Document is enclosed at Annexure – 1. 6. Terms & Conditions 6.1 The application proforma will not be returned unless withdrawn before expiry of the last date. 6.2 The applicants are advised in their own interest to ensure that all the points brought out the checklist are complied with in their application, failing which the offer is liable to be rejected. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. 6.3 The applicant shall be deemed to have accepted all the terms and conditions as laid down in the bidding document. 6.4 Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be deemed to have accepted be valid only if they are initialed/signed by the person or persons signing the application. 6.5 Selection of Vendors will be finalized by Selection committee APEDA comprising of officers, trade bodies other Govt. and Organizations constituted for the purpose.

		7.7 The decision of the APEDA shall be final and binding in this regard.
		7.8 For interpretation of any clause of this document, the decision of Chairman APEDA would be final and binding on both the parties i.e., bidder and APEDA.
8.	Pre-Bid Meeting	Pre bid meeting will be held after 7 days of release of advertisement.
9.	Selection Procedure	9.1 A Committee in APEDA will carry out a preliminary screening of the applicants and will shortlist the vendors fulfilling the prescribed requirements. The short listed applicants will be required to make presentation of their designs before the selection committee. The Score & Weightage Criteria is at Annexure – 2.
		9.2 The marking would be done for all the presentations by the selection committee on the above parameters. The vendor who scores minimum 60% marks (60 out of 100 marks) in technical presentations, will be shortlisted.
		9.3 The agency whose design will be shortlisted during technical presentation, will be required to submit necessary details including BOQ pertaining to the shortlisted design.
		9.4 A payment of Rs.3.00 Lakh (Rupees Three lakhs only) will be made to the agency whose design is selected. However, the bidder has to bear all the costs associated with the preparation and presentation. 9.5 The copyright of the design selected will be with APEDA.
