1. Place and Venue : Riyadh International Convention and Exhibition

Center – RICED, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

2. Date of the Event : 23rd to 26th October 2023

3. General Description of the Event:

Held in Riyadh International Convention & Exhibition Center - RICEC Riyadh (Saudi Arabia), Saudi Agro-Food is an international trade exhibition for food products, ingredients, and technologies. Taking place in October, this event provides an opportunity for exhibitors to showcase their products and services to an international audience. Saudi Agro-Food is a great platform for exhibitors to reach out to an international audience and demonstrate their expertise in the food industry. Visitors will have the chance to explore the latest products and services, as well as gain valuable insights into the industry. Furthermore, exhibitors can benefit from the opportunity to network with other industry professionals and build relationships with potential customers and partners.

Saudi Agro-Food is the perfect event for exhibitors to showcase their products and services to an international audience. With its focus on food products, ingredients, and technologies, this event provides a great opportunity for exhibitors to gain valuable insights into the industry and network with potential customers and partners.

And moreover as this year 2023 has been declared by the United Nations as International Year of Millets, thrust was laid for promotion and awareness of Millets and Millet based value added products of India.

4a. Neom: Neom is an initiative of Saudi Arabia's crown prince Mohammed bin Salman and forms part of the Saudi Vision 2030 plan to diversify the country's economy to reduce its dependence on oil. It is reportedly being largely bankrolled by the country's Public Investment Fund, which invests funds on behalf of the government.

Neom is a large area of the country that has been earmarked for development. Although often called a smart city, Neom is more accurately described as a region that will contain numerous cities, resorts and other developments.

4. APEDA's India Pavilion:

APEDA had taken 200 sq. mtr stall space in the exhibition for participation of APEDA and our registered exporters. APEDA's stall of 50 sq. mtrs space in the Exhibition at Hall No. 1 A Booth 1A-547 TO 1A 447 was designed by M/s. Riyadh International Exhibition Company Ltd. An attractive "Indian Pavilion" was set up for display of samples of individual exporters and promotion of APEDA Schedule Products from India. Exclusive display counters with shelves and fascias for display of company brand logo/product brochures/literature was created, which was well received and visited by Importers and Visitors.

APEDA Pavilion was inaugurated by Shri Abu Mathen George, Deputy Chief of Mission, Riyadh Embassy of India in Saudi Arabia. During the inaugural address, DCM addressed the participants and informed that there is a huge potential for import of Indian agro products in the country. Saudi is also showing keen interest for Indian products and to expand their import basket. Further, APEDA Officials guided the DCM through the APEDA pavilion and the participating members explained that they are currently importing to Saudi and this platform would help them in enhancement of the business.
