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Halal Accreditation Authority by Turkey

With an eye on 5.7 Trillion Dollar Global Halal Market, Turkish Parliament passed a legislation in November 2017 for the creation of a Halal Accreditation Authority. This was followed by a decree issued by the President on July 15 2018 as to how the Halal Accreditation Authority would be established, completing the legal framework for Turkey's drive to become a leading market player with state-guaranteed Halal labels.

Turkey's aim is to make the Halal Accreditation Authority the most authoritative body on the 'issue' in the Muslim world, and will adhere to the standards set by the Standards & Metrology Institute for Islamic Countries, a body under the OIC umbrella. Companies from Turkey and other Muslim Countries will be able to apply to the Halal Accreditation Authority for accreditation. Halal Accreditation Authority will act as Turkey's sole institution authorized to provide accreditation certificates.

As Turkey is aiming to increase its market share from US\$ 100 Billion to US\$ 400 Billion in a short span of time, All exporters who are interested to export Halal Products to Turkey and Also the Halal Authorities in India are suggested to get in touch with Halal Accreditation Authority of Turkey for smoothening export of Agricultural and processed food to Turkey.

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
