Market Access Notice

High Commission of Canada in India, Government of Canada informed that export of fresh banana and Baby corn to Canada has been approved by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency outlining the specific phytosanitary requirement that will apply to consignments of fresh banana and baby corn exported from India to Canada.

The detail phytosanitary condition to be followed for export of Fresh Banana and Baby Corn are given below:

S.No.	Commodity	Phytosanitary Conditions
1	Baby Corn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Phytosanitary certificate• Consignment should be free from husk, plant debris, soil, pests and leaves
2	Banana Fresh Fruit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Phytosanitary certificate• Origin of material must be clearly identified on shipping documents• Consignment should be free from soil, pests, leaves and /or plant debris

Exporters desiring to export fresh banana and baby corn to Canada may please follow the above mentioned phytosanitary requirement.
