REQUIREMENT OF INSPECTORS FOR MANGO EXPORT TO USA, JAPAN AND SOUTH KOREA FOR MANGO SEASON 2018

Dear Exporters,

Mango season 2018 is approaching. As per the requirements for export of Mangoes to USA, Japan, South Korea, Mauritius the export is to be done by sourcing the produce from registered farms.

APEDA has already implemented MangoNet software, under HortiNet System wherein the farmers of mangoes for exports are to be registered through State department of Horticulture/Agriculture. In this regard, letters have been written to department of Horticulture/Agriculture of the State Government(s). The farmers registration module for the next season has been opened and the registration was to completed by 28.02.2018.

The composite list of farmers will be extracted from the APEDA's HortiNet System (MangoNet) and would be sent to respective countries mentioned above. As per the requirement, the export of mangoes would be allowed from the registered farmers for the respective countries under Hortinet system

It may also be noted that the packhouse for Mango export to USA, Japan, South Korea and Mauritius have also got to be registered in accordance with packhouse recognition scheme of APEDA and compliance requirement as suggested by importing countries.

Exporters are suggested to provide business plan to the Export Mangoes by 9th March, 2018 as per the **Annexure I** enclosed to enable us to finalize the requirement for stationing of quarantine inspector from USA, Japan and South Korea. It may please be noted that the quarantine inspector would be invited based on the requirements to be received from exporters.



The financial implication towards deputation of inspectors would bear following:-

South Korea and Japan

The packhouses requiring the inspector for their facility will have to bear 100% cost of deputation including logistic arrangements i.e. Hotel, local travel etc. APEDA will bear 50% cost of the deputation in case the packhouse is able to export more than 100MTs.

100% cost of deputation will have to be paid in advance to APEDA before the posting of the inspector at the respective packhouse.

USA

1. The cost of sharing of deputation of US Inspector would be (50:50), 50% APEDA and 50% exporters.
