Sub: Advisory on testing of food products destined for export to Indonesia- reg

The Indonesian Quarantine Authority (IQA) has registered 17 Indian food testing laboratories with effect from 14.04.2025 for testing of agri products for export to Indonesia.

The approved laboratories are advised to strictly follow the Trade Notice No: APEDA/PPP/Q/2025 dated: 24.01.2025 (Procedure for Export of Peanuts and Peanut Products) with respect to the criteria, requirements and procedure to be followed for sampling, analysis and stuffing of shipments. The laboratories may adhere to the Maximum Level of Aflatoxin set by Indonesia in addition to requirements such as Pesticide Residues, Heavy Metals and Microbiological parameters for export of agri products.

It has been conveyed by IQA that due to the recurring non-compliances reported in previous years on exceeding levels of Aflatoxin in Peanuts, the IQA will enhance its monitoring program on Indian products exported to Indonesia, particularly groundnuts and wheat, by increasing the inspection frequency to at least 50%. It has also been decided by the IQA that in the event of any non-compliance detected during the monitoring process, the affected product will be subject to temporary suspension.

In view of the above, the laboratories registered by IQA are advised to follow the guidelines of Indonesia, Export Procedure of APEDA and other quality requirements to avoid any non-compliance in export consignments. Any deviation in this regard shall be viewed seriously.
