CIRCULAR

Phytosanitary requirements for export of Mango, Pomegranate fruits & arils, Oranges and Garlic from India to Canada

This is with reference to the export of mangoes, pomegranate fruits & arils, oranges and garlic from India to Canada.

NPPO-Canada vide letter dated 20.01.2026 informed that fresh mangoes, pomegranates, pomegranate arils, oranges and garlic are approved for entry into Canada. The General phytosanitary import requirements will apply, which are referenced in the Canadian Food inspection Agency (CFIA's) Automated import Reference System.

The requirements include:

- subject to inspection by the Canadian Food inspection Agency
- the origin of the material must be clearly identified on shipping documents must be free from soil, pests, leaves and/or plant debris
- if packed in cereal straw, the import requirements for straw must be met'

Note: additional phytosanitary requirements will apply if branches or leaves are still attached to the commodity and that the presence of soil in a shipment is prohibited.

Interested Exporters are requested to avail the opportunity and comply with the requirement for export of mangoes, pomegranate fruits & arils, oranges and garlic from India to Canada.
