The "Minimum Export Price(MEP) of US\$ 170 per Metric Ton F.O.B. or as notified by DGFT from time-to-time" as appearing in para 2 of Notification No. 41(RE 2010)/2009-2014 dated 31.03.2011 for the item description at Serial Number 44.01 of Notification No. 24(RE–2010)/2009-2014 dated 18.02.2011 is replaced by the "Minimum Export Price(MEP) of US\$ 200 per Metric Ton F.O.B. or as notified by DGFT from time-to-time".
- 3. Effect of this notification:

Minimum Export Price (MEP) of onions other than Bangakore Rose Onions and Krishnapuram onions will be USS 200 per Metric Ton F.O.B. It was USS 170 per Metric Ton as notified on 31.03.2011. There shall be no change in the MEP of Bangakore Rose Onion and Krishnapuram onion which continues to be USD 350 per Metric Ton F.O.B.
