Biofach Germany- An Overview

BIOFACH Germany is the leading Organic Trade fair in the World for promotion of certified organic products and takes place annually at Nuremberg, Germany. It is Organized by NürnbergMesse GmbH with its international patron IFOAM Organics International and National supporting Organization BÖLW- Bund Ökologische Lebensmittelwirtschaft. **This year the event was held from 10th-13th February 2026. Around 2,200 exhibitors from almost 90 countries and just under 32,000 trade visitors participated in BIOFACH 2026.**

The event provides a global platform to showcase organic products, discuss innovations, and foster international collaborations in the organic sector. With greater global emphasis on nutrition, health and the increased level of general awareness, particularly in the developed countries, the market for organic products has grown steadily over a period of time. With visitors and exhibitors from across the world, the event serves as a global meeting point for the Organic industry, fostering meaningful interactions and business connections. It enables manufacturers to present their companies and products to an international audience while simultaneously gaining insights into market trends, competitive positioning, and emerging opportunities.

In addition to the exhibition, the BIOFACH Congress continued to be the world's largest knowledge and discussion platform dedicated to the organic food sector. The congress provided a comprehensive forum for discussions on policy, market trends, innovation, and the future of the global organic movement.

Europe is one of the leading markets for organic products and around 30% of India's organic exports are destined to Europe. India has an equivalency with EU and Switzerland for unprocessed organic products and acceptance by Great Britain. Hence, Biofach Germany provides a good opportunity to explore and expand export of organic products to Europe.

India's participation as "COUNTRY OF THE YEAR" in Biofach 2026

India showcased its rich organic heritage at BIOFACH 2026, marking its significant presence as the "Country of the Year" at the world's leading trade fair for organic products, held from 10-13 February 2026 in Nuremberg, Germany. The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India organized India's participation with a prominent and high-impact presence that highlighted the country's rich agricultural heritage and its growing stature as a reliable global supplier of Organic Products. Trade visitors gained insights into Indian organic products, value creation models, and partnerships.



Highlights of India as Country of the Year at BIOFACH 2026

Opening ceremony of BIOFACH

The “Country of the Year” status at BIOFACH placed India at the centre of global attention from the international organic community, media, buyers, and policymakers, reaffirming India’s leadership in the global organic sector after a gap of 14 years.

VIP Tours

The official VIP tour of BIOFACH included India Pavilion as a key stop, enabling direct engagement with international dignitaries, decision-makers, and industry leaders, and providing enhanced visibility to Indian organic products and initiatives.

Networking Meet

India hosted a B2B Networking Meet between international buyers and exhibitors on 12 February 2026 during BIOFACH 2026, providing a well-structured platform for focused and productive business interactions. The meet facilitated direct engagement between global buyers and Indian organic exporters, helping strengthen trade linkages.

India Evening

An “India Evening” was organized during BIOFACH 2026 as a special networking and cultural event for exhibitors, guests, and VIP delegates. As the “Country of the Year,” India showcased its rich cultural heritage through music and dance performances, Indian cuisine, and traditional decor, presenting the country’s vibrant culture and hospitality.

Biofach Congress

India’s Country of the Year presence was further reinforced through a dedicated three-day programme at the BIOFACH Congress 2026, held from 10-12 February 2026. The sessions highlighted India’s organic ecosystem across policy frameworks, market access, exports, innovation, and youth-led transformation, positioning India as a future-ready and diverse organic sourcing destination.

Marketing and PR support

Extensive marketing and PR was undertaken by India as Country of the Year including prominent logo and visual placement on the BIOFACH homepage and digital platforms, exhibition guide, hall plans, exhibitor listings, and premium advertising spaces such as the exhibition guide cover page.

India’s visibility was further amplified through large-scale on-ground and digital branding, including digital signage at key entry points, metro bridge displays, LED screens, giga banners, giga frames, and branded lanyards, ensuring sustained recall among visitors throughout the fair and beyond.

Opening ceremony of BIOFACH:

India's prominence was marked at the opening ceremony, where Shri Rajesh Agrawal, Secretary (Commerce), Government of India, was invited on stage by the President of IFOAM – Organics International for an interactive discussion on the global organic sector and to address the audience. This high-level participation reinforced India's strong policy commitment and institutional support for organic agriculture.



At the opening inaugural ceremony of BIOFACH 2026 on 10th February 2026, attended by dignitaries such as Mr. Alois Rainer, German Federal Minister of Agriculture, Food and Regional Identity, Ms. Elisabeth Werner, Director-General Agriculture and Rural Development, European Commission, and other key delegates from key Organic producing countries, **Sh. Rajesh Agrawal, Secretary Commerce, Govt of India**, extolled the audience on India's prowess as one of the world's leading producer of Organic products and also highlighted the key amendments made in India's Organic regulation-the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP), thereby further strengthening the credibility of India's organic framework. He highlighted the complementarities between India and the EU Block countries, which are home to nearly 25% of the world's population and a combined GDP of nearly US\$ 25 trillion translating into a key trading block. He hailed the successful conclusion of negotiations of the landmark India–EU Free Trade Agreement (FTA), which will significantly enhance bilateral trade and investment ties, drive shared prosperity, strengthen resilient and diversified supply chains, and support sustainable and inclusive growth. He called for the quick conclusion of the Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA) on Organics between the two sides, to propel the growing but still nascent organic trade to new heights, that would build upon India's vast organic production base, supported by an impressive range of 15 agroecological regions, traditional farming knowledge and inherent organic practices.



Interaction with the German Agricultural Minister

Shri Rajesh Agrawal was a special invitee for an interaction with German Federal Minister for Agriculture, Alois Rainer. Discussions focused on strengthening and expanding trade opportunities in the organic sector between India and Germany, including deliberations on the India-EU FTA and enhancing bilateral cooperation in organic trade.



India Country Pavilion

The India pavilion was curated by APEDA in an impressive 1,074 square metres in Hall Number 1 block numbers- 203,217,221,229,237,200,105,115,125,131 and 137 and hosted 67 co-exhibitors, including organic product exporters, FPOs, cooperatives, organic certification and testing laboratories, state government organisations and commodity boards showcasing a vibrant display of products like Rice, Oilseeds, Herbs, Spices, Tea, Pulses, Cashew, Ginger, Turmeric, Large Cardamom, Cinnamon Mango Puree, Essential Oils amongst others.



Inauguration of the India Pavilion

The India Country Pavilion, was inaugurated by Sh. Rajesh Agrawal, Secretary Commerce, Govt. of India, in the presence of Sh. Vivek Dewangan, Addl. Chief Secretary, Govt. of Manipur, and other senior dignitaries of the Govt. of India and State Governments such as Dr. Mandeep Singh Tuli, Minister (Personnel), Embassy of India, Berlin, Sh. Shatrughna Sinha, CGI, Munich, Sh. Hage Tari, Secretary, Industry, Govt. of



Arunachal Pradesh , Sh. Taru Talo Secretary, Trade & Commerce Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Sh. Nishant Warwade, Secretary(Agriculture), Govt of Madhya Pradesh, Sh. Abhishek Dev, Chairman APEDA, Shri Saket Kumar, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Sh. Visit of the high-Level Dignitaries

The India Pavilion witnessed visits from several eminent dignitaries, reflecting the growing global interest in India's organic sector. The Pavilion was visited by the German Federal Minister for Agriculture, Alois Rainer, along with climate activist Luisa Neubauer, who showed keen interest in India's organic products and export potential.



The Ambassador of Romania also visited the Pavilion and interacted with Indian exporters.

In addition, Prof. Dr. Markus Schick, State Secretary, visited the India Pavilion and appreciated the diversity of products and India's strong presence at the event.



These high-level visits significantly enhanced the visibility and importance of India's participation at the exhibition.

Co-Exhibitors under the India Pavilion

Exhibitors from over 20 Indian states participated in the exhibition, reflecting the country's vast agro-climatic diversity and regional strengths. These include Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jammu & Kashmir, Delhi, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana and others. The participation highlighted region-specific organic produce and value-added products, demonstrating India's expanding engagement in international organic trade.



Organic Market Place & FPO Zone

A dedicated Organic Marketplace of 63 sqm was set up under the India Pavilion to provide farmers with a platform to showcase and promote their certified organic products to the international buyers at BIOFACH 2026. In addition, an FPO Zone covering 126 sqm was set up to highlight products from Farmer Producer Organizations and strengthen their market linkages in the global organic market.

Products Displayed

The Indian pavilion showcased a diverse range of organic products such as Rice, Oilseeds, Herbs, Spices, Pulses, Cashew, Ginger, Turmeric, Large Cardamom, Cinnamon, Mango Puree, Essential Oils, Tea, Coffee, Millets etc. India's participation at BIOFACH 2026 represented a significant scale-up over previous editions, representing a 50% expansion in terms of area and participation making it the top non-EU exhibitor at BIOFACH and amongst the top 5 exhibiting countries, reflecting the steady growth of Indian organic exports, rising international demand and increased participation from exporters, Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), associations, cooperatives and state institutions.



Rice Zone

A dedicated rice zone was set up within the APEDA Pavilion to showcase the rich diversity of Indian rice varieties. The display featured an extensive range including Basmati rice, non-basmati rice, Red Rice, Brown Rice, Gobindbhog Rice, Boka Rice, Chak Hao Rice, and Joha Rice, reflecting India's vast agro-climatic diversity and heritage grains.

Culinary Showcases

The pavilion offered attendees immersive experiences through curated food tastings of Indian organic delicacies. Visitors enjoyed aromatic biryani made with premium organic basmati rice, golden turmeric latte, and live cooking demonstrations featuring vibrant flavours and aromas of Indian cuisine through curated food tastings. The highlight was the serving of fragrant biryani prepared with premium organic basmati rice and select exotic spices, offering a celebration of India's traditional culinary heritage. Besides, cuisines with innovative fusion of Indian organic products with European culinary styles were presented through live demonstration and offered to the visitors.



Dishes such as Govind Bhog Risotto Milanese, Chak Hao and Millet Tabbouleh with Feta and Pomegranate, Red Rice Croustade, and Saffron Govindbhog Kheer were served, allowing attendees to taste and appreciate the rich diversity and unique flavours of India's organic produce.



Cultural Zone

Classical dance performances including Kathakali and Bharatnatyam were organized at the 24 sqm Cultural Zone, showcasing the richness and diversity of India's cultural heritage. These performances highlighted the grace, spirituality, and traditional aesthetics of Indian art forms, attracting considerable interest from the international visitors. The cultural presentations complemented the India Pavilion by reflecting the country's vibrant traditions and timeless heritage, creating a holistic experience of India's organic products and cultural legacy. Besides, Yoga demonstrations added the flavour of spirituality to the cultural demonstrations.



Organic Heena Art

Cultural elements such as Organic henna art (mehndi) were showcased, providing insights into India's rich traditions and enhancing the overall experience for visitors.



MASCOTS

Two mascots on organic Mango and Indian organic Rice were organized as a part of promotional activities during the event.



Media & Publicity

India's participation in the event was widely publicized through social and electronic media. APEDA engaged two Germany-based influencers to promote India's presence at the event. The influencers extensively covered the India Pavilion, showcased the diverse range of products, interacted with exporters, wet sampling, chefs and highlighted key activities and exhibits, thereby enhancing the visibility of India's participation among international audiences.



In addition, professional media coverage was arranged through journalists from ANI and PTI, who reported on India's participation, key highlights of the Pavilion, and business engagements, ensuring wider outreach and coverage in national and international media.

Meetings and Engagements

During BIOFACH 2025, Indian representatives engaged in several strategic meetings:

Meeting with the Commerce Secretary

Sh. Rajesh Agrawal, Commerce Secretary, Government of India, interacted with the Indian exporters and German buyers at a meeting held on 11th February 2026 at Hotel Le Méridien, Nürnberg during BIOFACH 2026. Discussions focused on trade opportunities and the various issues faced by Indian exporters in accessing the European Union market.



Meeting with senior officials from the European Commission

On the sidelines of BIOFACH 2026 at Nuremberg, a focused meeting was held with the senior officials from the European Commission. The discussion was led by Sh. Abhishek Dev, Chairman APEDA from the Indian side and Mr. Luis CARAZO JIMENEZ, Head of Unit (Organic), European Commission in the presence of Dr. Alka Rao, Advisor, FSSAI.

The discussions focused on strengthening and expanding the equivalence framework between the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP) and the EU organic regulation, with emphasis on ensuring continued market access and expanding the scope of recognition for trade facilitation. Both sides acknowledged the importance of the MRA in promoting bilateral organic trade and agreed to work closely towards addressing technical gaps, ensuring regulatory coherence, and reinforcing the credibility of organic certification systems.



Meeting with Naturland

The APEDA officials had a meeting with representatives from Naturland. The focus of the meeting was to understand how the private standards are operating in different countries including EU and India. It was informed that Naturland standards are applicable over and above the regulatory standards of that Country.



Meeting with Demeter

The APEDA officials visited the Demeter stand and had a meeting with the representatives from Demeter. The focus of the meeting was to understand how Demeter is operating in different countries including EU and India. It was informed that Demeter standards are applicable over and above the regulatory standards of that Country.

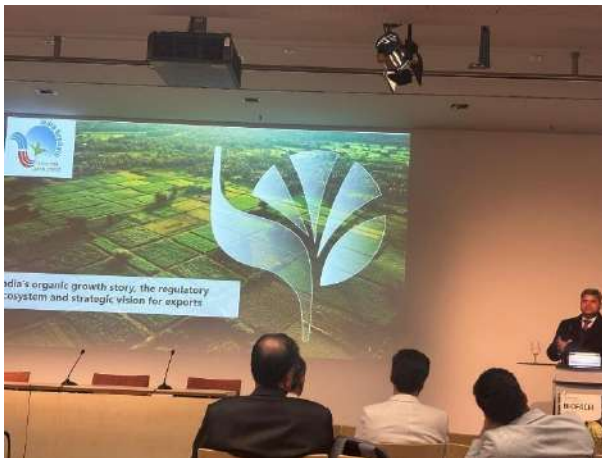


India Country of the year Session at BIOFACH Congress:

In addition to the exhibition India's Country of the Year engagement was further strengthened through a dedicated three-day programme at the BIOFACH Congress 2026. Held from 10 to 12 February 2026, the congress sessions focused on India's organic ecosystem across policy, markets, exports and youth-led transformation, and were designed to position India as a credible, diverse and future-ready partner in the global organic ecosystem.

Day 1: Country of the year 'opener': Regulation – market- strategies

The opening session on Tuesday, 10 February 2026, set the regulatory and strategic context with presentations on the National Programme for Organic Production, India's organic growth story, regulatory ecosystem and export vision and the emerging role of cooperatives in organic farming. Dr. Saswati Bose, General Manager, APEDA, provided an overview of the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP), outlining India's regulatory credibility and international acceptance. Sh. Raman Kumar, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation, highlighted the emerging role of cooperatives in strengthening organic farming systems and farmer participation. Sh. Abhishek Dev, Chairman, APEDA, presented India's organic growth story, emphasizing the regulatory ecosystem, institutional support, and strategic roadmap for expanding India's presence in global organic markets. The session concluded with an interactive discussion, followed by a summary and wrap-up of key takeaways.



Day 2: Accelerating India's Organic exports

On Wednesday, 11 February 2026, the theme focused on accelerating exports to frontier markets highlighting the significance of Mutual Recognition Agreements, addressing food safety, international harmonisation and trust building, presenting global opportunities, organic success stories, models and smallholder empowerment from the State of Meghalaya and Assam and opportunities in export of organic spices. The first session addressed by Dr. Alka Rao, Advisor, FSSAI, discussed the role of food safety regulations in building international trust and harmonisation. Perspectives on inclusive growth were shared by Mr. Virendra Mittal, Commissioner and Secretary to the Government of Assam, who highlighted the role of organic farming in empowering smallholders. Dr. Vijay Kumar D, Commissioner and Secretary, Government of Meghalaya, presented state-led initiatives, organic success stories, and community-driven models. The second session highlighted frontier markets for Indian organic products, with Mr. Sameer Mehra, Founder & Director, Suminter India Organic and Chairman, Association of Indian Organic Industry, sharing insights on emerging regions and market opportunities. Ms. Vijeeshna Vimala, Assistant Director, Spices Board, elaborated on export opportunities in organic spices. The day concluded with interactive discussions and a summary of key export-focused strategies.



Day 3: Tradition to Transformation: India's Youth taking Forward the Organic Heritage

The concluding session on Thursday, 12 February 2026, highlighted youth-led transformation, building the next generation of global organic leaders, on empowering youth innovation in sustainable food systems, on youth engagement in organic value chains, and experience sharing by young entrepreneurs. The first session examined strategies for attracting youth to organic farming and trade, with Dr. P. Uday Praveen, Director of Agriculture, Government of Assam, sharing policy and capacity-building perspectives. Dr. Alka Rao, Advisor, FSSAI, outlined how regulatory frameworks can enable youth-led innovation in sustainable food systems. Mr. Lanuakum Imchen, Director – Network and Cooperation India, IFOAM Organics Asia, discussed youth engagement across organic value chains. The second session featured experience sharing by young organic entrepreneurs, including Mr. Gaurav Mittal, Managing Director, Aromatic & Allied Chemicals (P) Ltd., and Ms. Siddhi Karnani, Director, Parvata Foods Pvt. Ltd., who shared insights on entrepreneurship, market access, and innovation. The sessions concluded with an interactive exchange and a wrap-up emphasizing the importance of youth-led leadership for the future of India's organic sector.



Networking Meet

A B2B Networking Meet between international buyers and all exhibitors at India Pavilion was organized on 12 February 2026, offering a well-structured platform for focused and productive business engagements. The event brought together over 60 participants, including importers and trade professionals from more than 10 countries, including the Netherlands, the Republic of Korea, Italy, Germany, the UK, and others. During the interaction, the Indian exporters gave an overview on the potential products for export. The importers present also highlighted the products that they are presently dealing with and their expectations from the Indian Market.



Exhibitor Evening

Followed by Networking Meet, India organized a grand “**India Evening**” jointly with Nuremberg Messe during BIOFACH 2026 as a special networking and cultural event for exhibitors, guests, and VIP delegates. As the “Country of the Year,” India showcased its rich cultural heritage through music and dance performances, Indian cuisine, and traditional décor, reflecting the country’s vibrant culture and hospitality. The event also facilitated informal interactions and networking between importers and exporters from different countries.



Marketing and PR support

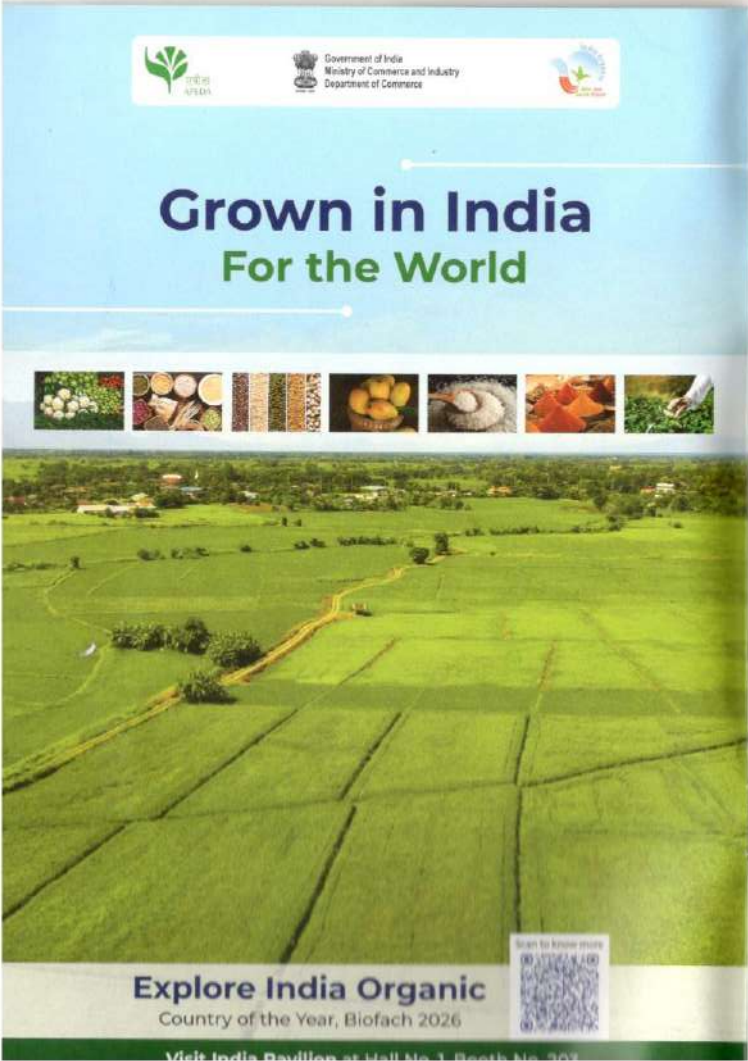

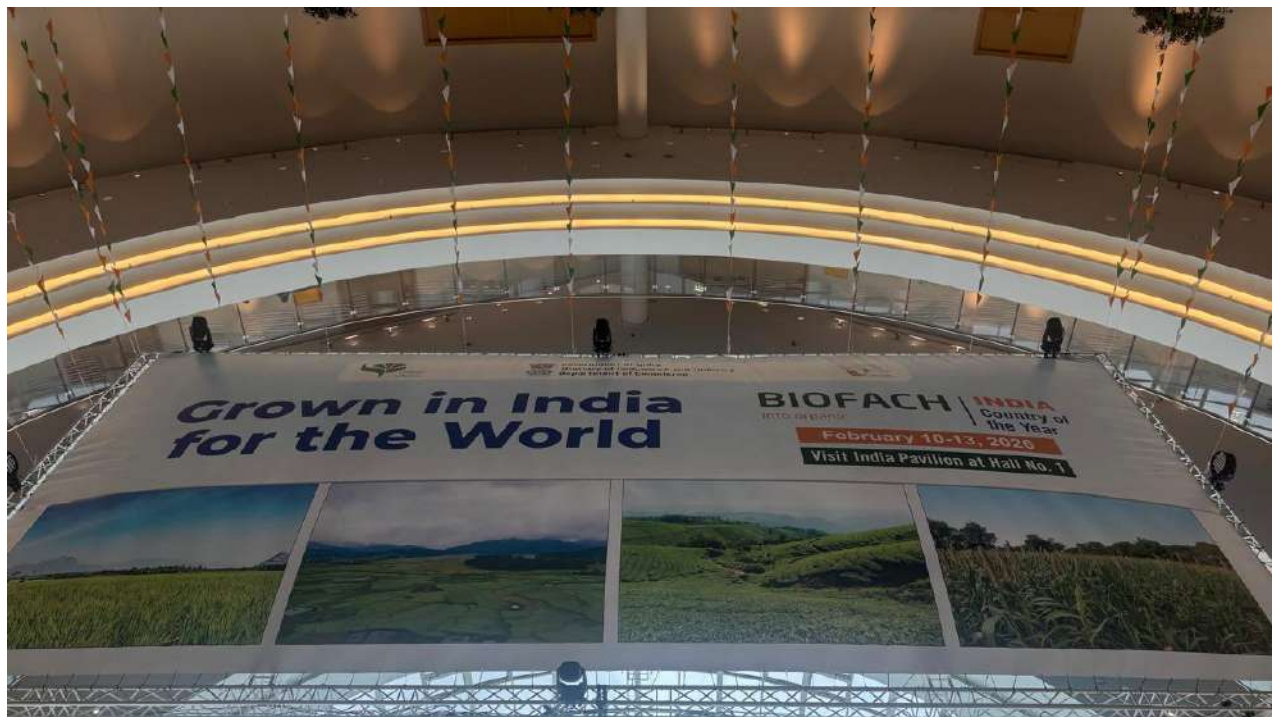
